Antonio Banderas (*Pain and Glory*) and Penélope Cruz (*Parallel Mothers*) unite with Oscar Martínez (*The Distinguished Citizen*) in this biting funny behind-the-scenes satire of filmmaking from Argentine writer-directors Mariano Cohn and Gastón Duprat. Finding his legacy lacking in prestige, an octogenarian tycoon (José Luis Gómez) impulsively decides to finance a great work of cinema. Demanding the best of the best, he purchases the rights to a Nobel Prize-winning novel about sibling rivalry and renowned filmmaker Lola Cuevas (Cruz) is recruited to mastermind

this ambitious endeavour. A visionary with a penchant for offscreen theatrics, Lola casts as her embattled co-leads a pair of actors with massive talent but even bigger egos: Hollywood heart throb Félix Rivero (Banderas) and radical theatre actor Iván Torres (Martínez). Both are legends, but not exactly best friends. Through a series of increasingly eccentric trials set by Lola, Félix and Iván must confront not only each other, but also their own legacies. Awash in egomania and deliciously absurd hijinks, *Official Competition* is a playful yet sharp comedy skewering wealth, art, and pride.

Language Lessons

Directed by Natalie Morales (*Parks and Recreation*) and written in collaboration with her co-star Mark Duplass (*The Morning Show*, *Safety Not Guaranteed*), this charming and award-winning comedy follows a Spanish teacher and her student whose online connection takes on far more importance than either could have anticipated.

For his 45th birthday, wealthy Californian Adam (Duplass) receives a surprise gift from his choreographer partner: 100 weekly Spanish lessons with Cariño (Morales), a vivacious expat who teaches virtually from her home in Costa Rica.

Adam is unconvinced at first; a self-described "creature-of-habit", he's unsure where or how this new element will fit into his carefully-structured routine. But after unexpected events turn his life upside down, Cariño becomes a lifeline he didn't know he needed, and a complicated emotional bond develops.

Upending classic meet-cute tropes, this clever and unassuming film effortlessly shifts between comedy and pathos, echoing the ups and downs of life. Bittersweet, honest and fresh, *Language Lessons* is a disarmingly moving exploration of friendship and connection.

A FOCUS ON SPAIN'S MOST OSCAR-WINNING DUO

Celebrating their 2022 Oscar nominations for *Being the Ricardos* and *Parallel Mothers*, and the 30th anniversary of *Jamón Jamón*, the Festival is proud to present these iconic collaborations of Penélope Cruz and Javier Bardem and encore screenings of Almodóvar's *Parallel Mothers*, for which Penélope won the Best Actress Award at the Venice International Film Festival. One of the most charismatic couples in cinema, Penélope Cruz and Javier Bardem met in 1992 while filming Bigas Luna's *Jamón Jamón*, a sensual film that launched their careers.

They coupled up and married after filming Woody Allen's *Vicky Cristina Barcelona* (2008), for which Penélope's won the 2009 Best Supporting Actress Oscar, making history as the first Spanish actress to win an Oscar. In 2022, the duo became the sixth married couple to be nominated in acting categories in the same year at the Oscars, joining the likes of Richard Burton and Elizabeth Taylor.

A powerful mother-daughter drama, *Ama* reflects stories of women who are facing the trials and tribulations of motherhood alone.

When Pepa (Tamara Casellas) is kicked out of her friend's house after several warnings, she ends up living on the streets with Leila, her six-year-old daughter. Cast adrift, with no support network and no one to ask for help, Pepa and Leila struggle on their own to find a place to live.

Each hurdle they must overcome takes them on a journey, which leads to mother

and daughter becoming closer, a change from their previously distant and practically nonexistent relationship. A new bond is formed between the two and unrealistic expectations about maternity are finally dissolved.

Imbued with social realism, *Ama* features a stellar performance from newcomer Tamara Casellas, who won the Best Actress award at the 2021 Málaga Spanish Film Festival for her performance. This graceful directorial debut of Júlia de Paz Solvas shines a light on the mythicised ideals and beautiful imperfection of motherhood.

Gradually exchanging secrets and emotions with an element of mistrust, these four individuals will have a more

Bringing together a cast of renowned actors such as Salva Reina, Ana Polvorosa (*My Big Night*), Pol Monen and Andrea Duro, *Carpoolers* is filled with dialogue, comical situations and tension as it questions first impressions.
